RE: Kellogg (US-54) and Webb Interchange “Kellogg, Cypress to Wiedemann”

Dear Sir or Madam,

I would like to inform you of the upcoming Kellogg (US-54) and Webb Interchange Project in Wichita, Kansas, which also will provide connection to and from the Kansas Turnpike (I-35). The project budget is approximately \$100 million dollars, with advertising beginning on April 30, 2015 in the Kansas Register (http://www.kssos.org/pubs/pubs_kansas_register.asp), for a projected June 12, 2015 letting date.

The project consists of expanding Kellogg (US-54) to an urban freeway with a grade separated interchange at Webb Road. The following are elements of the project:

- *6,100 ft of 6-lane urban freeway*
- *2-lane one-way frontage roads*
- *2,100 ft of arterial street improvements*
- *3,800 ft of Soldier-Pile (Tie-Back) walls*
- *2,250 ft of MSE walls*
- *Box girder bridge*
- *Two (2) signalized intersections*
- *Grading*
- *Storm sewer*
- *Sanitary sewer*
- *Waterline*
- *Lighting*
- *Highway sign trusses*
- *Pavement marking*
- *Landscaping*
- *Utility relocations*
