Sealed Bids for the construction of the Wastewater System Improvements will be received by OWNER, at the office of 531 Main Street, Seneca, KS 66538, until 1:30 PM local time on July 11th, 2017, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

The Project is generally described as follows: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for the construction staking; mobilization; erosion control; grass seeding; traffic control; erosion control; and all other project components further divided into wastewater manhole improvements, wastewater gravity sewer line rehabilitation, wastewater treatment facility improvements, and wastewater collection system improvements.

Wastewater Manhole Improvements: The improvements includes approximately 73 manhole cover replacements, 17 flush tank replacements, 1 cleanout replacement, 1 manhole replacement.

Wastewater Gravity Sewer Line Rehabilitation: The improvements include approximately 61,000 linear feet of pre-installation video inspection and sewer cleaning, heavy or mechanical sewer cleaning as required, point repairs, 58,000 linear feet of 8" cured-in-place pipe, 1,400 linear feet of 10" cured-in-place pipe, 1,900 linear feet of 15" cured-in-place pipe, and 30 service line repairs – chemical grouting or open cut methods.

Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements: The improvements include main lift station rehabilitation including the replacement of existing valves at the main lift station, cathodic protection, replacement of sump pump and piping. The work also involves installation of influent flow monitoring improvements which includes a magnetic flowmeter and transmitter, vault, piping, electrical and other incidental and appurtenant work.

Wastewater Collection System Improvements: The improvements includes approximately 240 linear feet of directional drilled 8-inch gravity sewer main, 1 connection to an existing manhole, and the removal and replacement of an existing manhole and appurtenances, and the re-connection of 3 residential sewer services.
