Sealed Bids for the construction of the Wastewater Lagoon Facility Improvements will be received by OWNER, at the office of 349 Washington Avenue, Long Island, KS 67647, until 1:00 PM local time on January 25, 2018, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

The Project is generally described as follows:

General: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for the improvements at the wastewater lagoon facility. The general overall project improvements include construction staking; mobilization; erosion control; approximately 55 feet of 3-inch PVC forcemain; 5.00 acres of grass seeding; and all other incidental and appurtenant work required to complete the improvements as shown and specified.

Wastewater Lagoon Facility Improvements: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for the improvements at the wastewater lagoon facility including removal of the existing influent structure, influent piping, transfer structures, transfer piping, valves, valve piping, discharge manholes and discharge piping; removal and land application of liquid sludge; approximately 18,500 cubic yards of common excavation; approximately 18,000 cubic yards of compacted fill; sludge removal and disposal; installing a concrete influent structure, two concrete transfer structures; distribution manhole; 3,050 square yards of slope erosion protection; 331 linear feet of 8-inch PVC sewer piping; 130 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron sewer piping; construction staking; trenching; backfilling; over excavation; compaction; concrete work; site grading; backfilling and testing; and all other incidental and appurtenant work.

Alternate No. 1: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for installing 3,050 square yards concrete slope erosion protection on the sides of the primary treatment lagoon cells, therefore deleting riprap slope erosion protection.

Alternate No. 2: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for installing 2,650 square yards crushed concrete slope erosion protection on the sides of the storage cell.

Alternate No. 3: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for installing 2,740 linear feet of woven wire fencing with signs.
