## General Notice

The City of Palco (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

**City of Palco, KS - Water System Improvements**  
WCI No. 21-600-268-01

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the office of the City Clerk located at 508 Main St, Palco, KS 67657, until September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 11:00 AM local time. At that time, the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

**Water Treatment Plant:** Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for construction of a water treatment plant that includes: excavation; backfilling; grading; 36'x42' pre-engineered metal building addition; site and building concrete work; architectural work; masonry block construction; process piping; mechanical and electrical equipment; valves, hydrants, & appurtenances; 150 gpm nitrate treatment and regeneration equipment (pre-negotiated by Owner); automated liquid chlorine injection equipment; two centrifugal high service pumps; bathroom/office equipment; generator; existing pressure control shack removal and demolition; on-site raw water tank and appurtenances; on-site nitrate waste tank and appurtenances; piping; gravel surfacing; grass seeding; erosion control; well piping and electrical improvements; and all other incidental and appurtenant work required to complete the improvements as shown and specified.

**Alternates:** Replace bolted steel raw water and nitrate waste water tanks with glass-fused-to-steel bolted tanks; installation of sealant on water treatment plant concrete floors; supply and installation of office room furniture; and all other appurtenant work required to complete the proposed alternates.

Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent via the prospective Bidder's delivery service. The shipping charge amount will depend on the shipping method chosen. #### **Instructions to Bidders.**

For all further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

This project is funded in part by Kansas Department of Commerce Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and permanent financing from Kansas Department Health and Environment Revolving Loan (KPWSLF). Bidder's attention is called to the required compliance with CDBG and KPWSLF funding requirements.

Bidders attention is called to the required compliance with conditions of Section 3 of the 1968 Housing Act, Section 109 of the 1984 Housing and Community Development Act, the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Segregated facility.

Bidders on this work, including subcontractors or vendors, will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 (Equal Employment Opportunity). Requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.

All contracts and subcontracts exceeding \$100,000, at any tier under a SRF Loan Agreement shall comply with the Anti-Lobbying Act, Section 319 of Public Law 101-121, and file an Anti-Lobbying Certification form, and the Disclosure of Lobbying Activities form, if required, to the next tier above.

Bidders on this work, including subcontractors or vendors, will be required to comply with the Kansas Act Against Discrimination (K.S.A. 44-1001 et.seq.) and the Kansas Age Discrimination in Employment Act (K.S.A. 44-1111 et.seq.). Requirements for bidders are explained in the Bid Documents.

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Bidders must fully comply with Subpart C of 2 CFR Part 180 and 2 CFR 1532, entitled Responsibilities of Participants Regarding Transactions. Contractors, subcontractors, or suppliers that appear on the Excluded Parties List System at [www.sam.gov](http://www.sam.gov) are not eligible for award of any contracts funded by the KDHE State Revolving Fund programs or Small Town Water and Sewer Infrastructure Assistance grants.

All requirements of the Build America, Buy America (BABA) Act, 41 USC 8301 note, and all applicable rules and notices, as may be amended, shall be complied with if applicable to the infrastructure project. Pursuant to HUD's Notice, "Public Interest Phased Implementation Waiver for FY 2022 and 2023 of Build America, Buy America Provisions as Applied to Recipients of HUD Federal Financial Assistance" (88 FR 17001), any funds obligated by HUD on or after the applicable listed effective dates, are subject to BABA requirements, unless excepted by a waiver.
