Sealed Bids for the construction of the Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements will be received by OWNER, at the office of the City Clerk, City of Morland; 503 Main Street; Morland, KS 67650, until 11:00 AM local time on August 12, 2025, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

The Project is generally described as follows:

General: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for the construction/improvements at the wastewater lagoon facility. The general overall project improvements include construction staking, mobilization, erosion control, approximately 7.5 acres of grass seeding, corrosion resistant liners, telemetry, and all other incidental and appurtenant work required to complete the improvements as shown and specified.

Wastewater Lagoon Facility Improvements: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for the wastewater lagoon facility improvements. The improvements include approximately 16,930 cubic yards of common excavation, approximately 14,705 cubic yards of earthwork compaction, 341 linear feet of 8-inch PVC lagoon piping, 119 linear feet of 8-inch DIP lagoon piping, 1 Influent Structure, 2 Transfer Structures, 2 Distribution Manholes, 2,907 square yards of Concrete slope erosion protection on Cells 1 and 2; trenching; backfilling; over excavation; compaction; concrete work; site grading; access drive restoration and all other incidental and appurtenant work required to complete the improvements as shown and specified.

Alternate No. 1: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for installing 2,907 square yards Rock RipRap slope erosion protection on the sides of the primary treatment lagoon cells, therefore deleting Concrete slope erosion protection.

Alternate No. 2: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for installing 3,559 square yards Rock RipRap or Crushed Concrete slope erosion protection on the sides of the storage cell.

Bid Security will be required in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidder qualifications may be required in accordance with Instructions to Bidders.

Contract time will be set in accordance with the Agreement.

OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

This project is funded by Kansas Department of Commerce Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and a Kansas Department Health and Environment Revolving Loan (KWPCRF). Bidder's attention is called to the required compliance with CDBG and KWPCRF funding requirements. Associated certifications and the completion of other documents will be required for the successful completion of the project. All bidders are required to comply with Local, State, and Federal regulations as stated in the bid documents.

Bidders attention is called to the required compliance with conditions of Section 3 of the 1968 Housing Act, Section 109 of the 1984 Housing and Community Development Act, the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Segregated facility.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the presidents Executive Order No. 11246 (Equal Employment Opportunity) as amended. Requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.

"Bidders must fully comply with Subpart C of 2 CFR Part 180 and 2 CFR Part 1532, entitled Responsibilities of Participants Regarding Transactions. Contractors, subcontractors, or suppliers that appear on the Excluded Parties List System at [www.sam.gov](http://www.sam.gov) are not eligible for award of any contracts funded by the KDHE State Revolving Fund programs or Small Town Water and Sewer Infrastructure Assistance grants."

All contracts and subcontracts exceeding \$100,000, at any tier under a KDHE loan or grant agreement shall comply with the Anti-Lobbying Act, Section 319 of Public Law 101-121, and file an Anti-Lobbying Certification form, and the Disclosure of Lobbying Activities form, if required, to the next tier above.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and Federal prevailing wage rates to be paid under the contract.

This agreement is for services related to a project that is subject to the Build America, Buy America (BABA) Act, 41 USC 8301 note, and all applicable rules and notices, as may be amended. Absent an approved waiver, all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in this project must be produced in the United States, as further outlined by the Office of Management and Budget's Memorandum M-24-02, "Implementation Guidance on Application of Buy America Preference in Federal Financial Assistance Programs for Infrastructure."

Contractor shall include Manufacturer's Certification for BABA requirements for all BABA-covered items to be incorporated into the infrastructure project. Contractor shall comply with BABA requirements, including coordination with manufacturers, distributors, and suppliers to correct deficiencies in any BABA documentation. For any change orders, Contractor shall provide BABA documentation for any new products or materials required by the change. Contractor shall designate the responsible parties for determining the final categorizations for all project items.
