The Project includes the following Work:

Water Supply System Improvements: Work includes furnishing all the labor, materials, and equipment for construction of approximately 13,110 L.F. of 4", 6" & 8" water line by directional drill and open trench, valves and appurtenances, excavation, backfilling, grading, gravel surfacing, concrete pavement, grass seeding, erosion control, and all other incidental and appurtenant work required to complete the improvements as shown and specified.
